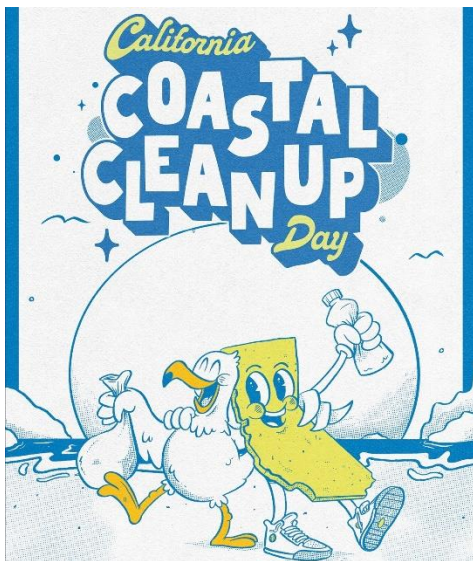


August – Shoreline Park Walk

January – Archery Range Day

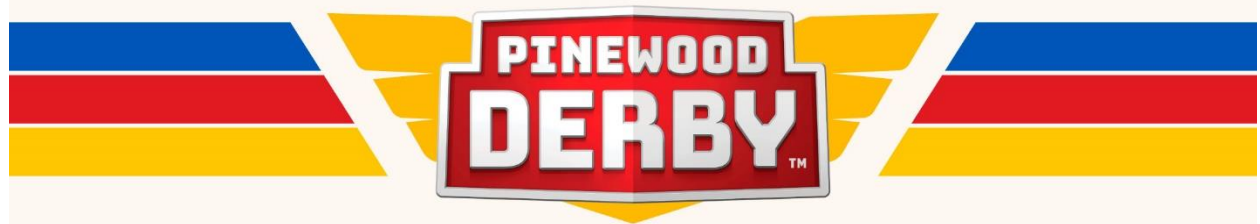
****REGISTRATION REQUIRED****

****REGISTRATION REQUIRED****

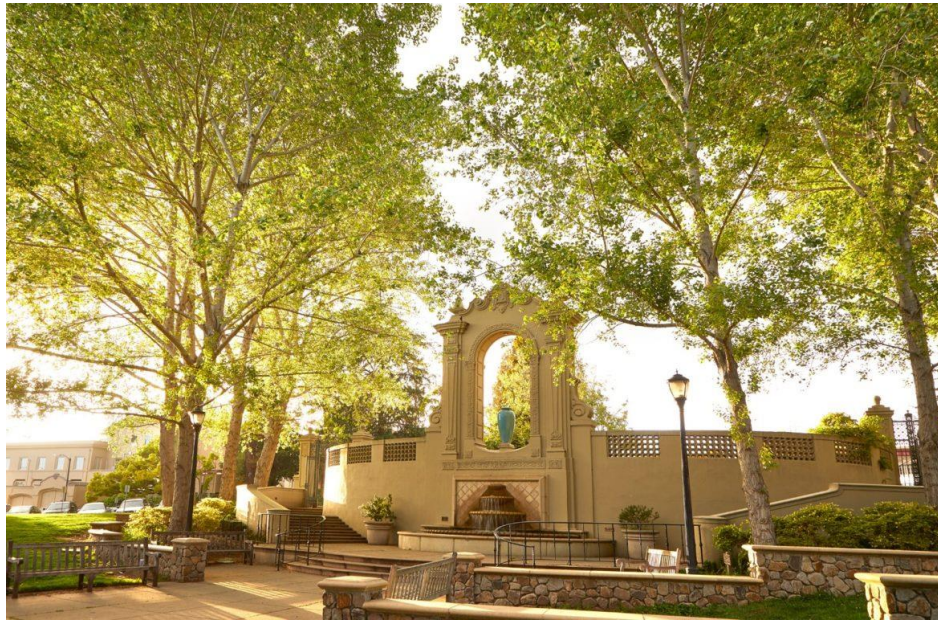
When: Saturday, February 3rd from 9am – 1:45pm
