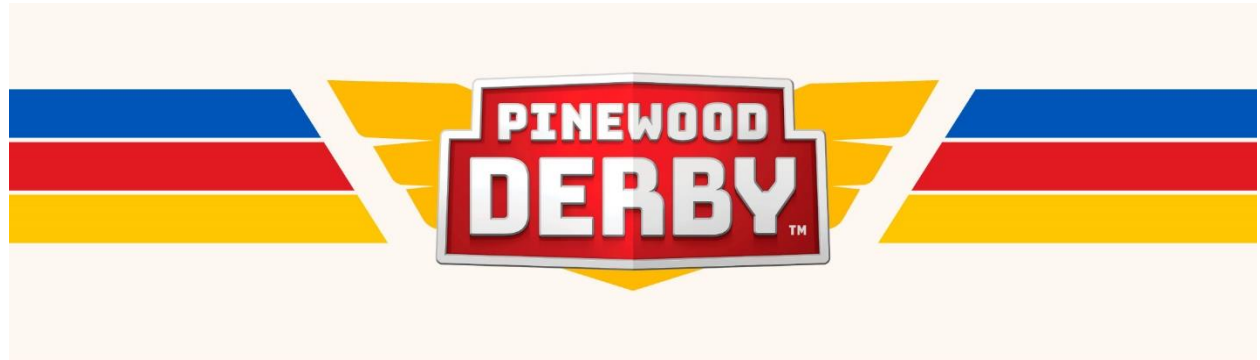
**When:** Saturday, January 24<sup>th</sup> – Hour slots from 10am – 3pm

### **July – Fourth of July Parade**

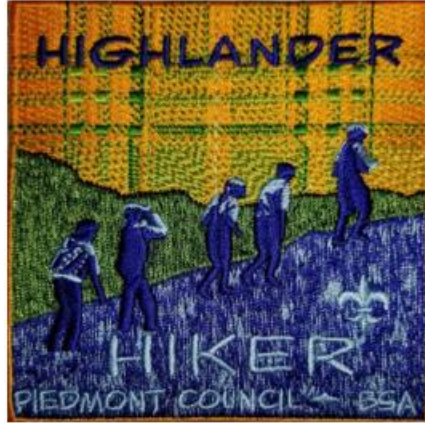
**When:** Friday, July 4<sup>th</sup> from 10:30am – 12pm
